

# Front Position

## WARNING

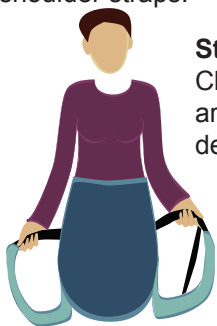
NEVER UNFASTEN THE WAIST STRAP WHEN A CHILD IS IN THIS CARRIER. THIS COULD CAUSE A FALL AND INJURY.

## IMPORTANT

Have someone assist you the first few times you use the AngelPack baby carrier until you are comfortable doing it on your own.

Keep one hand on the child at all times to keep him or her secure.

Make major adjustments before placing the child in the carrier. Make sure the secure straps are attached to the shoulder straps.



### Step 1:

Clip the waist strap buckles together around your waist. Next, clip the shoulder strap buckles together on each side.

### Step 2:

Pick the child up and hold him or her against your chest in a seated position, just over the waist strap.



### Step 3:

Keeping the child secure, slide shoulder straps over your shoulders, sliding your arms in through the loops formed by the straps.

### Step 4:

Clip the secure straps together to prevent the shoulder straps from slipping off your shoulders.



The child is now held securely against your chest. You can both enjoy a comfortable ride and bonding time.



## Removing the child

Start by unfastening the secure straps buckle. While keeping the child secure with one arm, remove the shoulder strap with the opposite hand and repeat the process with the other side.

# Back Position

## WARNING

THIS POSITION IS ONLY SAFE FOR A CHILD OVER THE AGE OF FOUR (4) MONTHS AND WHO HAS GOOD NECK STABILITY AND HEAD CONTROL.



### Step 1:

Lay the AngelPack on a deep seated chair or bed, with the inside facing up and the waist strap towards your edge, allowing enough space for you to sit down. Fasten the shoulder buckles together. Sit the child on the top half of the carrier. **Do not leave the child unattended.**

### Step 2:

Sit in front of the child, just off the waist strap and fasten the waist strap around your waist. Reach back with both arms and slide arms through both shoulder strap loops. Gently and slowly pull the shoulder straps forward and onto your shoulders as the child slides into place.



### Step 3:

Fasten the secure straps just under your collar bones.

That's it! The child is secure on your back and you are ready to go.



## Sleeping hood

Attach the hood to the inside pocket's velcro. Pull the hood over the child's head and attach hooks to ribbons on the shoulder straps. Adjust the cords to avoid the child's head from falling backwards.



## Removing the child

Start by sitting on a deep seated chair or bed and unfastening the secure strap buckles and remove the hood. Slowly remove both shoulder straps while carefully lower the child down. Once the child is down, unfasten the waist buckle.

# Tips and Tricks

Use the hood to provide discreet nursing on the go or protection from the sun. Re-use the package your AngelPack baby carrier came in to store small toys and incidentals in your diaper bag.
